Restaurants

Restaurante El Pilon: An old carpenters workshop set into the rocks, which has now been converted into an authentic Spanish restaurant. Serving fresh local produce within a relaxed atmosphere, offering great views over the village. Outdoor seating available during the summer months. Cuisines - International, Mediterranean, Spanish. Taberna-Restaurante Casa Paco: set within the main square ‘Plaza Almijara’, with wonderful views overlooking the church of Nuestra Senora de la Asunción and the Paseo de las Tradiciones. With cosy indoor seating and the option of outdoor alfresco dining within the square. Serving traditional Spanish tapas; while also being a great spot for a coffee, while enjoying the sunshine and soaking up the local atmosphere. Cuisines - Mediterranean, Spanish. Hierbabuena Cómpeeta: A popular option with the local expats, known for its fresh, healthy menu. The restaurant/cafe serves breakfast, lunch and dinner, as well as artisan breads and cakes, coffee and tea. Internationally renowned local wines can also be purchased to drink in or take out.

Restaurante El Pampano: Serving organic and gourmet food, open for breakfast, brunch, lunch and dinner.

Located on the Plaza Vendimia, with great views overlooking the ‘hanging houses’.

This restaurant offers indoor and outdoor seating, with its large terrace overlooking the village, the surrounding mountains and the sea. Cuisines - International (including Sushi),

Bars

La Carpinteria: this central bar hosts indoor live music events and therefore gets very crowded at the weekends. A casual, laidback atmosphere, with a good selection of wines, beers, spirits and cocktails. They also offer an informal food menu, with tasty pizzas and burgers. Telephone no. +34 635 46 77 88.

La Bodega: a small Spanish bar, popular with the locals due to its authentic, cosy atmosphere. This place is full of character, with its original old wine press and hanging Serrano hams (jamon) above the bar. Shopping

Azalea Artesania & Ceramica: a traditional shop selling crafts and ceramics, ideal gifts from your Spanish holiday. Located opposite the main car park.

Tienda de Vinos Almijara: local wine shop next to Plaza Almijara. Owned by the nearby vineyard of 'Bodega Almijara', the best place to buy the vineyards own wines and other local spirits.

Art Galleries: Cómpeeta is home to 2 small art galleries, which are definitely worth a visit when staying in Cómpeeta - 'Galeria Centro de Bellas Artes' and 'Galeria Luz de la Vida'.

Market: Cómpeeta hosts a market every Saturday between 09:00 and 13:30 in the main car park. Stalls include local fresh fruit and vegetables, nuts, spices, olives, clothes and accessories, household goods and homeware. This small market can be explored within 10 minutes.
